Key Stage 2 Remote Learning

How will remote learning work?

KS2 will be provided with at least 4 hours of remote learning a day.

All lessons will be provided on Google Classroom. There will be some online lessons available for your class.

Lessons will be provided from across the curriculum subjects to develop children's knowledge, skills and understanding.

At the beginning of each week, a weekly subject timetable will provide timings and an overview of activities for the week ahead - this will be shared on Seesaw. Don't worry if it takes a little longer for your child to complete some of the activities. All children learn at their own pace.

For work completed in the afternoon away from Google Classroom, please share examples or photos on Seesaw. It would be fabulous to see learning and skills developing at home.

What if my child needs help with the learning activity?

Through live lessons, teachers will teach and explain the activity. Children will be able to ask their teacher for help if they need it.

Live lessons will be recorded for the children to refer back to - these can be replayed at home so that instructions are available at any time.

If, after using these recordings, further support is needed, please contact your class teacher via the class Seesaw account. Teachers will be teaching during the day but they will get back to you as soon as they possibly can.

Weekly Worship

A weekly worship assembly will be available for children. This is based on a different theme each week and is provided by the Diocese of Hereford.

A website link will be uploaded to Seesaw.

Class Google Meets

We understand how hard it is for children to not be able to see their classmates. We are going to be sending information soon about Class Google Meets.

We need to make sure we have all the right safety procedures in place before we start.

What if my child needs help with the resources for remote learning?

If your child is having issues with accessing home learning, please use the email below and someone will get back to you as soon as possible. For example, you may contact this email if:

- you experience problems with login details
- you would like a hard copy of the learning resources

This will help us support children at home as quickly as possible. Teachers will be busy teaching lessons during the day so they may not be able to respond straight away. We want to ensure our children have all the resources available to support their learning at home.

What should I do with all the work that my child completes?

Teachers will be keeping a daily record of the children who complete work and those who attend the online lessons.

Any work that your child completes using Google Classroom, will be automatically saved to their Google Drive. Teachers will be able to access this work and provide feedback. Please encourage children to check and respond to their feedback.

For those children working on paper copies, please photograph the work that is completed each day and send this to the class teacher on Seesaw. Teachers will provide feedback as soon as they can. This will help teachers keep track of your child's progress.
